### 2014 Program for Writers with Disability Guidelines

Writers are eligible to spend 12 months on the program. During this period, participants will identify their writing goals and will be supported to achieve those goals.

Writers on the program may:

- attend free workshops on craft and publishing
- receive a one-on-one feedback session on their work in progress (either at SAWC or via email/Skype **(via appointment, but note that this service gets booked up very quickly)**)
- be connected with potential mentors/ editors
- be supported in applying for funds for mentors/ editors
- receive advice and support on publishing opportunities
- attend networking sessions
- be given assistance in forming or joining writers groups
- be eligible to apply for SAWC scholarship to our Professional Development workshop series
- be eligible for opportunities to participate in other SAWC projects.

All events, except where advertised, are at SA Writers Centre. We have disability access, a laptop with Voice Recognition Software, a high hearing unit and accessible toilets.

SA Writers Centre is an inclusive organisation that is committed to ensuring access for all writers to its program of events and opportunities.
